To protect our staff, contractors, students and the wider school community, Bandemonium is committed to the following policies and actions in relation to COVID:

1. We will monitor and follow the advice and directives of NSW Health/NSW Dept of Education/Catholic School NSW or any other relevant regulatory authority.
2. Our Bandemonium tutor we will closely monitor all students for any for cases of COVID-19. Any student displaying any COVID-like symptoms will be requested to physically distance themselves away from the group and to call parents/guardians to pick up child urgently.
3. All students are encouraged to wash/sanitise their hands before they enter the classroom where band lessons are run. They will also be reminded and requested to do again on exit from the room. Students are requested not to touch, use or play anyone else's instruments, belongings or music stands.
4. No Bandemonium team member/tutor to assemble, clean, instruct or repair a student's instrument, without wearing/using Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)
5. All students are encouraged to follow social distancing requirements. Tutors will set room up to allow for greatest space between students (where applicable or feasible)
6. Any Bandemonium team member/tutor that has travelled overseas or has come in contact with a person infected by COVID-19 is required to notify management immediately and self-isolate at home for 14 days; if they develop any symptoms they must see their doctor and follow their advice, including taking a COVID-19 test if required - they must not return to work until they give a negative test result and and/or clearance by their GP and all symptoms have resolved
7. If any Bandemonium team member/tutor develops any COVID related symptom, they will be required to stay at home, consult their GP, including taking a COVID-19 test if required. They must not return to work until they give a negative test result and/or clearance by their GP and all symptoms have resolved.
